First and third Tuesday monthly for Revd Josh to meet with prospective wedding couples and baptism families. Appointments only please, through Penny.

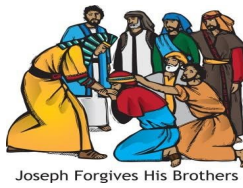
